20 miles – New Tunnelton Bridge to Bedford Boat Club
3. Adult Leaders, Troop, Crew, or Post
15 miles – Lawrenceport to Bedford Boat Club

There will be a Kayak Division added if participation warrants.

Rules

1. Registration by unit leaders beginning at 12:30 pm the day of the race.
2. Units must furnish their own canoes and paddles with approved flotation device (life jacket) for each person –*****Life jackets must be worn and may not be used as a kneeling pad.**
3. Two or three persons in each canoe.
4. A troop, crew, or post may enter as many teams as it wishes.
5. All participants must be at the starting points no later than 12:30 pm.
6. Participants must be registered members of a troop, crew, post or council.
7. Participants must be qualified blue swimmers or equivalent.

Council insurance surcharge is being covered by interested citizens.

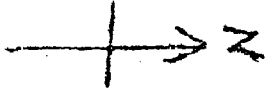
