Personal Medications must be noted on your updated medication form turned in at registration. All medications must be in pharmacy issued containers. Put in zip lock bag. No loose pills or pill-boxes.

Definition of Uniform terms occasionally used in Scouting: (Not official BSA terms but used by many in Scouting)

Class A's = First five items on list. Class B's = Items 2-5 with a White Stag Scouting T-shirt.

Note: White Stag will use the official Scout Uniform only during the week, the first * five is required dress before moving to the campsite. Two White Stag T-shirts will be provided; we will wear the Class B uniform most of the time with a White Stag T-shirt. We suggest you put your name on all your personal items. A backpack must be used for transporting your gear from the registration area to your campsite and on the afternoon and overnight outpost hike. Participants will carry their backpack/personal equipment. Participants must not use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued.

Mark all items with your name so we can return it to you when you loose it.
