Calling all Campmasters!!!

Who is a Campmaster?

A Campmaster is an adult Scouter who uses his experience, training, and knowledge of the Scouting program to help both Scouts and their adult leaders develop skills in the outdoors.

To be a Campmaster, you must: 1. Be at least 21 years old. (A Campmaster assistant must be at least 18 years old); 2. Be knowledgeable in and be able to teach basic and advanced Scouting skills; 3. Be supportive of national and council policies and regulations; 4. Be familiar with Camp Maumee; 5. Have completed the Campmasters Orientation Program; 6. Be willing to be “first in - last out” for at least one weekend a year at Camp Maumee.

What do Campmasters do?

A Campmaster agrees to be responsible for the checking in and checking out of units for the weekend they agree to be Campmaster. If the troop(s) that are staying at Camp need help working with the boys in a skill in which you are knowledgeable, then you are encouraged to assist them. Otherwise, your job is to answer any questions or help make their stay enjoyable at Camp Maumee. Campmasters also need to recruit an assistant to help with the check-in and check-out of the troop(s). Campmasters don't have to camp out with the troops. They sleep in the Campmaster's cabin. They stay warm and dry.

What do I need to do to become a Campmaster?

It's really simple. If you are a registered Scouter, 21 years or older, and you know what the Scouting program is all about, then you start the process by filling out the application on the back and sending it to the Scout Service Center in Bloomington. Applications are reviewed by the Campmasters Committee. After approval, the applicant is contacted to find out which weekend(s) he/she can be at Camp.
